Bourgeois in 1937, the old Théâtre des Variétés had once been one of the most modern venues in Brussels during the golden age of the occupied by the Nazis and later by the British, and was converted into a cinema in the 1960s before finally becoming a bandoned in the $\,$ '80s and falling into a state of ruin. Barcelona-based architects Flores & Prats and Brussels-based OUEST Architecture have now undertaken the rehabilitation of the structure for Bruxelles Laïque, a private entity funded partly by

the public administration, that is dedicated to the promotion of citizen activities with a strong social character.







